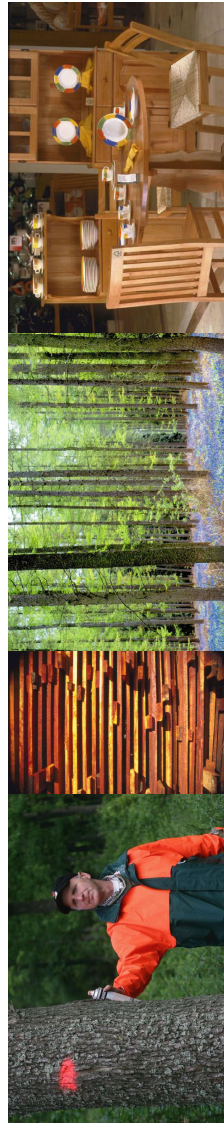

- a person; and, where relevant,
- the organization or company on behalf of which the comment is being submitted; and
- the formal status of the person within this organization.

Comments submitted on the Irish FSC Forest Management Standard in development or under review will be considered as being publicly available (without information about the contributor) unless the contributor explicitly requests that the comments should be treated as confidential.

The National Forest Management Standard

The Irish National Initiative of FSC is developing an Irish FSC Forest Management Standard. The standard is being developed under the purview of the Steering Committee by a Standard Development Group with the help of technical experts on specific issues.

As per the FSC process standard, FSC Ireland would like to invite all interested parties to register as members of the Consultative Forum (CF). All meetings, including the Consultative Forum, will be facilitated using the existing FSC Ireland ground rules, available on www.irishforestcertification.com. Where the input from the Consultative Forum addresses a technical issue, the expert opinion of relevant resource people may be consulted.

Any people who do not agree to the standard development process as outlined in the FSC Ireland workplan may submit comments. However, the Consultative Forum is the structure through which formal comments should be submitted.
